Psalm: 139: 1-5, 12-18 (said by alternate verse)

- 1 Lord, you have searched me out and known me;
you know my sitting down and my rising up;
you discern my thoughts from afar.
- 2 **You trace my journeys and my resting-places,
and are acquainted with all my ways.**
- 3 Indeed, there is not a word on my lips,
but you, O Lord, know it altogether.
- 4 **You press upon me behind and before,
and lay your hand upon me.**
- 5 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me;
it is so high that I cannot attain to it.
- 12 For you yourself created my inmost parts;
you knit me together in my mother's womb.
- 13 **I will thank you because I am marvellously made;
your works are wonderful, and I know it well.**
